GOAL: IDENTIFY A PRIORIZED REGIONAL COUNTER NARCOTICS REQUIREMENTS LIST BASED ON RECEIVING ASSISTANCE FROM OUTSIDE THE REGION.



DISCUSSION:

- **THERE IS STRONG AGREEMENT THAT NARCOTIC TRAFFICKING POSES A THREAT TO THE CENTRAL AND SOUTH ASIAN REGION, AND A STRONG DESIRE TO ATTACK THE PROBLEM**
- **MANY DIFFERENT ORGANIZATIONS CURRENTLY EXIST TO FIGHT ILLICIT TRAFFICKING, THESE EFFORTS SHOULD SUPPORT THE ACTIVITIES OF THESE ORGANIZATIONS (E.G., PARIS PACT, CARICC, ETC.)**



RECOMMENDATION:

MAIN PRIORITIES

- **INFORMATION SHARING**
 - **EXAMPLE: CARICC; AGREEMENTS; MECHANISMS FOR SHARING INFORMATION; MODELS; MODELS OF JOINT INTELLIGENCE ANALYSIS**
- **IMPROVEMENT OF COMMAND AND CONTROL SYSTEMS AT INTERAGENCY LEVEL**
 - **EXAMPLE: REGIONAL/NATIONAL/LOCAL; MODELS OF COMMAND AND CONTROL**



RECOMMENDATION (CONTINUED):

- **TRAINING**
 - **EXAMPLE: REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER; DUAL USE PRODUCTS**
- **DEMAND REDUCTION**
 - **EXAMPLE: PROGRAM MODELS; PUBLIC INFORMATION; REHABILITATION PROGRAMS; ETC.**
- **LIVELIHOODS ASSISTANCE**
 - **EXAMPLE: ASSISTANCE TO FARMERS; ALTERNATIVE LIVELIHOOD; CREATION OF JOBS**



RECOMMENDATION (CONTINUED):

- **IMPROVE LAW ENFORCEMENT STRUCTURES AND REINFORCEMENT OF THE BORDERS**
 - **EXAMPLE: PROJECTS; MODELS**
- **PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAMS**
 - **EXAMPLE: MODELS OF PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAMS**
- **IMPROVEMENT OF NATIONAL LEGISLATURES AND MECHANISMS OF THEIR COOPERATION**
 - **LEGISLATIVE REFORM; ETC.**



RECOMMENDATION (CONTINUED):

- **PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAMS**
 - **EXAMPLE: MODELS OF PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAMS**

- **IMPROVEMENT OF NATIONAL LEGISLATURES AND MECHANISMS OF THEIR COOPERATION**
 - **LEGISLATIVE REFORM; ETC.**

- **FIGHTING CORRUPTION**
 - **EXAMPLE: SALARY SUPPLEMENTS; MONEY LAUNDERING**



RECOMMENDATION (CONTINUED):

- **SEVERAL REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF AFGHANISTAN EXPRESSED THE NEED FOR:**
 - TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT
 - IMPROVED PROVINCIAL DRUG CONTROL STRUCTURES
 - SUPPORT TO ALTERNATIVE LIVELIHOODS AND JOBS FOR FARMERS
 - SPECIALIZED TRAINING TO CONDUCT COOPERATIVE OPERATIONS WITH REGIONAL PARTNERS
