# MISSION STATEMENT

**The purpose of the Central and South Asia Counter-Narcotics Security Working Group (CNSWG) is to facilitate the reduction of cultivation in the source zone with provision of alternative livelihoods, have greater successes in interdiction and reduce demand in transit and consuming countries. The group will provide:**

- o Open, cooperative environment for exchanging information
- o Synchronize ongoing national and regional counter narcotics efforts
- o Prioritize requirements to ensure efficient resource application
- o Ensure delivery of programmed activities from donor countries and identify gaps.
- o Provide recommendations to political and diplomatic structures to mobilize national and international support

- **Other entities, i.e. NATO, UNODC, etc.**

### **•Sub-Groups (Subject Matter Experts)**

- **chartered based on identified priorities**



## **FREQUENCY and METHODOLOGY:**

- **Senior Executive Council** – meet in 6 months with follow-on meeting to be determined at that time.

Recommendation is semi-annually

- Chairman w/ Secretary on rotating basis
- Host nation proposes dates and solicits topics
- Deputy Secretary provided by next host
- **Sub-groups** – quarterly, as necessary, and 2 days prior to Senior Executive Council meetings
  - Present issues, propose solutions for presentation to the Council.
