## ***General Comments***

- **SEC reviewed and approved with minor changes the recommendations of the Capacity Building and Information Subworking groups**
- **SEC conducted a review of the CSACNSWG charter**

## ***SEC Developed Recommendations***

- **Recommendation 1 (Charter Review – Mission Statement):** Develop an alternative mission statement to succinctly identify the purpose of the CSACNSWG organization
  - **Task assigned to:** Permanent Secretary
  - **Task guidance:** The Permanent Secretary will develop an alternative mission statement for SEC approval
    - **Address law enforcement**
    - **Ensure the statement reflects the organizations complimentary and cooperative role**

## ***SEC Developed Recommendations***

- **Draft Mission Statement:**
  - ***To support law enforcement initiatives in the region that facilitate the elimination of narcotic production, trafficking and poppy cultivation in the source zone.***

## ***SEC Developed Recommendations***

- **To achieve the mission the CSACN WG will:**
  - **Align itself with the strategic intent of the Paris Pact**
  - **Improve Law Enforcement and contribute to demand reduction**
  - **Establish sub working groups as required to synchronize national and regional counter narcotic initiatives**
  - **Make recommendations to national and international bodies on the future direction of law enforcement activities**
  - **Encourage greater exchange of information among member nations**
  - **Prioritize and make recommendations to donor countries for regional programs that increase strategic and operational capacity**
  - **Encourage greater regional participation**
  - **Contribute to the enhancement of Alternative Livelihoods**

## ***SEC Developed Recommendations***

- **Recommendation 2 (Charter Review – Membership): SEC will offer charter membership to the Governments of Germany and Turkey, and offer observer membership to the Government of the United Arab Emirates**
  - **Task assigned to: Permanent Secretary**
  - **Task guidance: The Permanent Secretary will determine the means to formally offer these memberships through the appropriate diplomatic channels**
    - **Encourage attendance at the next SEC meeting**

## ***SEC Developed Recommendations***

- **Recommendation 3 (Charter Review – Frequency & Methodology): For the SEC Chairmanship position, add as a length of tenure, “for one year.”**
  - Task assigned to: Complete
  - Task guidance: Submit to SEC for approval

## ***SEC Developed Recommendations***

- **Recommendation 4 (Charter Review – Priorities and Sub-groups):**
  - Delete “Political/Legislative Reform”
  - Add: “Precursor Control”
  - Task assigned to: Complete
  - Task guidance: Add “Precursor Control” as the third priority / sub-group – this will become the next activated subgroup
