

Prof. Dr. May-Britt U Stumbaum is Professor of Security Studies and Strategic Competition at the George C. Marshall Center for European Security in Garmisch, Germany. She is also Director, The SPEAR Institute and Associated Researcher at the Centre for Intelligence and Security Studies, German Armed Forces University Munich. Commended for her ability to “translate complex political concepts from academia into actionable analysis for practitioners” (former DCMC General Mark O. Schissler), she also advises the European Union and the German government on foreign and security matters in the Asia-Pacific region.



Until July 2020, she served as Team Leader of #APRAN, the EU’s Asia-Pacific Research and Advice Network, an internal think tank serving the EEAS and EC Services. Previous positions included Director, NFG Research Group “Asian Perceptions of the EU”, & Fellow at Einstein-Program on East Asian Security (Freie Universität Berlin); Senior Research Fellow and Executive Director, China and Global Security Program at the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), serving among others on the Pentagon’s Minerva project on Chinese dual use technology / defense industry; Fritz Thyssen Fellow at WCFIA, Harvard University; Director, International Forum on Strategic Thinking/Senior Researcher, German Council on Foreign Relations (DGAP); Head, Asia Department, Berlin Partners.

May-Britt U Stumbaum holds an MSc from the London School of Economics (LSE), a PhD on EU-China relations from the Freie Universität Berlin and a Habilitation on norm diffusion and EU-India/EU-China security cooperation from the Jacobs University Bremen/Bundeswehr University Munich.

Prof. Dr. Stumbaum won multiple awards, among them the highly competitive European Foreign and Security Policies Studies Grant (PhD full scholarship from three European foundations) and Fellowships e.g. by the EU Institute for Security Studies, the DAAD/AIGCS, the Taiwan Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Fritz Thyssen Foundation (Harvard). She participated in leader programs such as the Loisach Group, the BAKS Leadership Seminar, American Council on Germany Young Leaders’ Group, the Korea/Europe Next Generation Leaders, the Manfred-Woerner-Seminar and the ASEF Young Leaders Symposium.

May-Britt U Stumbaum co-founded Women In International Security Deutschland (WIIS.de) in 2003 (President until 2008) and served as the first female president for the Tönissteiner Kreis (until 2018), an association of 900 internationally minded German leaders. Current involvements encompass e.g., Board Member, Clausewitz Society, member of the CSCAP EU Committee, and annual stints as LTC (R) German Airforce at the Ministry of Defence/security policy section.

Prof. Dr. Stumbaum is a regular commentator in national and international media and testified in 2012 to the US Congress’ U.S.-China Economic and Security Review Commission on EU-China security matters.
